Planned 4 hour outage in Sun Peaks, Heffley Creek, Upper Louis Creek to affect 2,200 customers

On Monday, April 27, 2026 BC Hydro will be conducting a planned power outage in the Sun Peaks and Heffley Creek areas to complete maintenance work which will help improve reliability to the region. This work is essential to enhance the dependability, safety and efficiency of the region's power system.

Over two thousand customers in the Sun Peaks and Heffley Creek areas rely on the distribution line that feeds the region. In order to ensure the safety of our crews and the public, power to our infrastructure needs to be turned off and this important work must be done in daylight. The outage will impact about 2,200 customers.

Outage details:

- **Date:** Monday, April 27, 2026
- **Time:** 7am to 11am
- **Customers affected:** approximately 2,200

All impacted customers with up-to-date contact information have already received initial notifications via e-mail and automated phone calls. A second round of notifications will be sent two weeks ahead of the outage.
